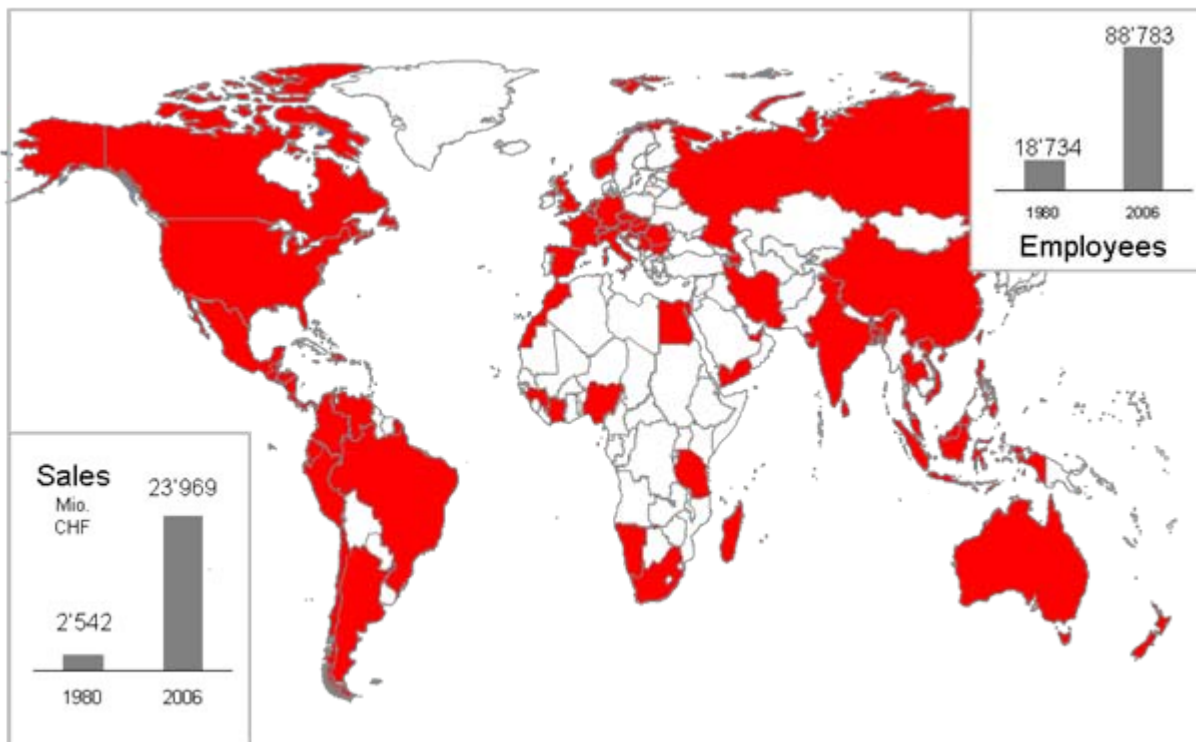

Our mission is to be the world's most respected and attractive company in our industry – creating value for all our stakeholders.

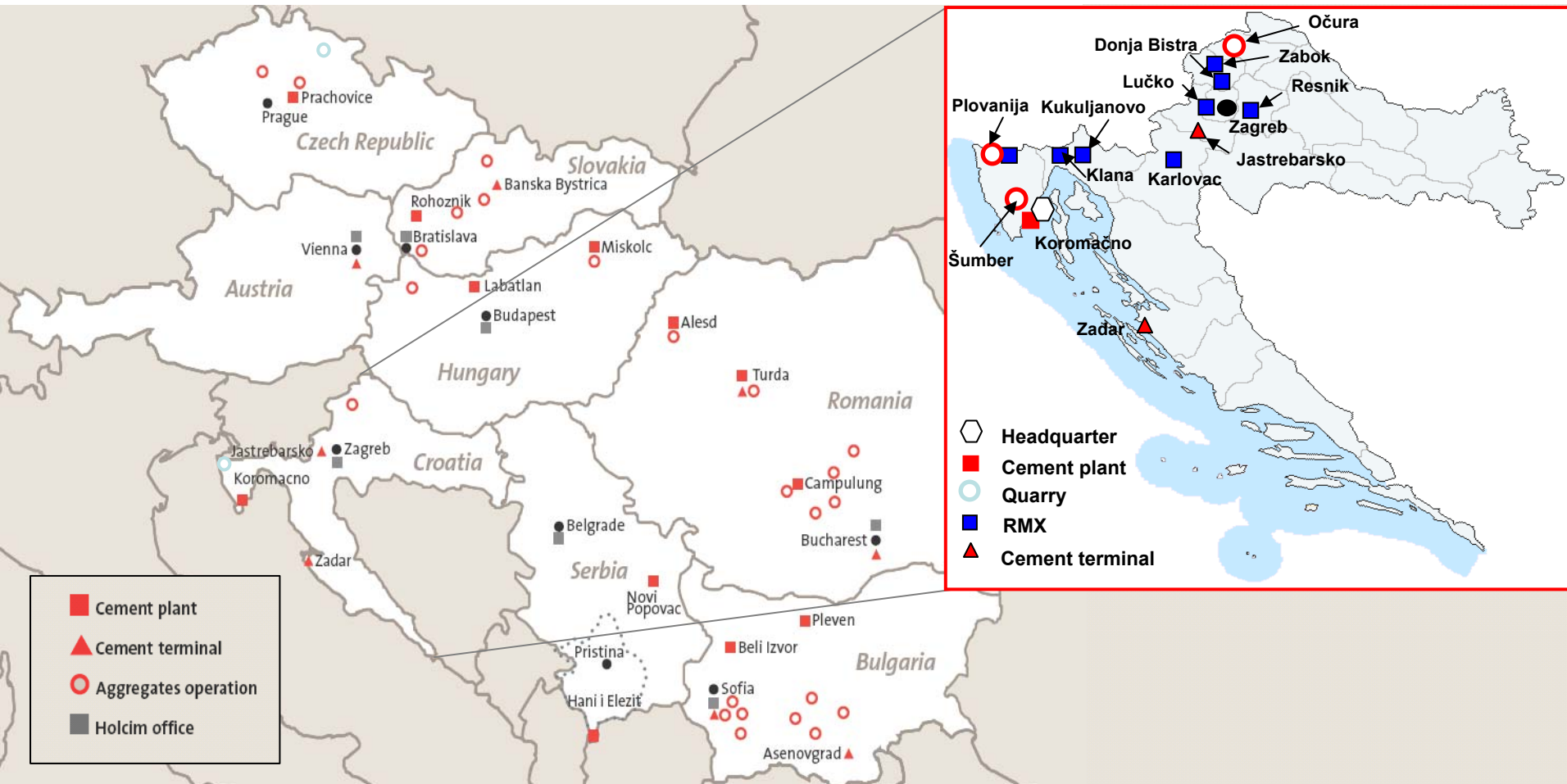

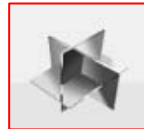

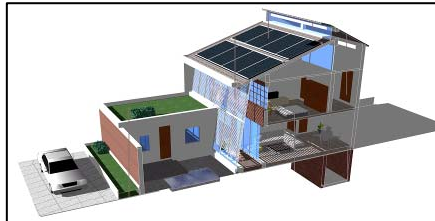
Global Holcim Awards Gold 2009 hand-over in Fez July 16, 2009

Global Holcim Awards Bronze prize 2009 hand-over in Beijing June 19, 2009

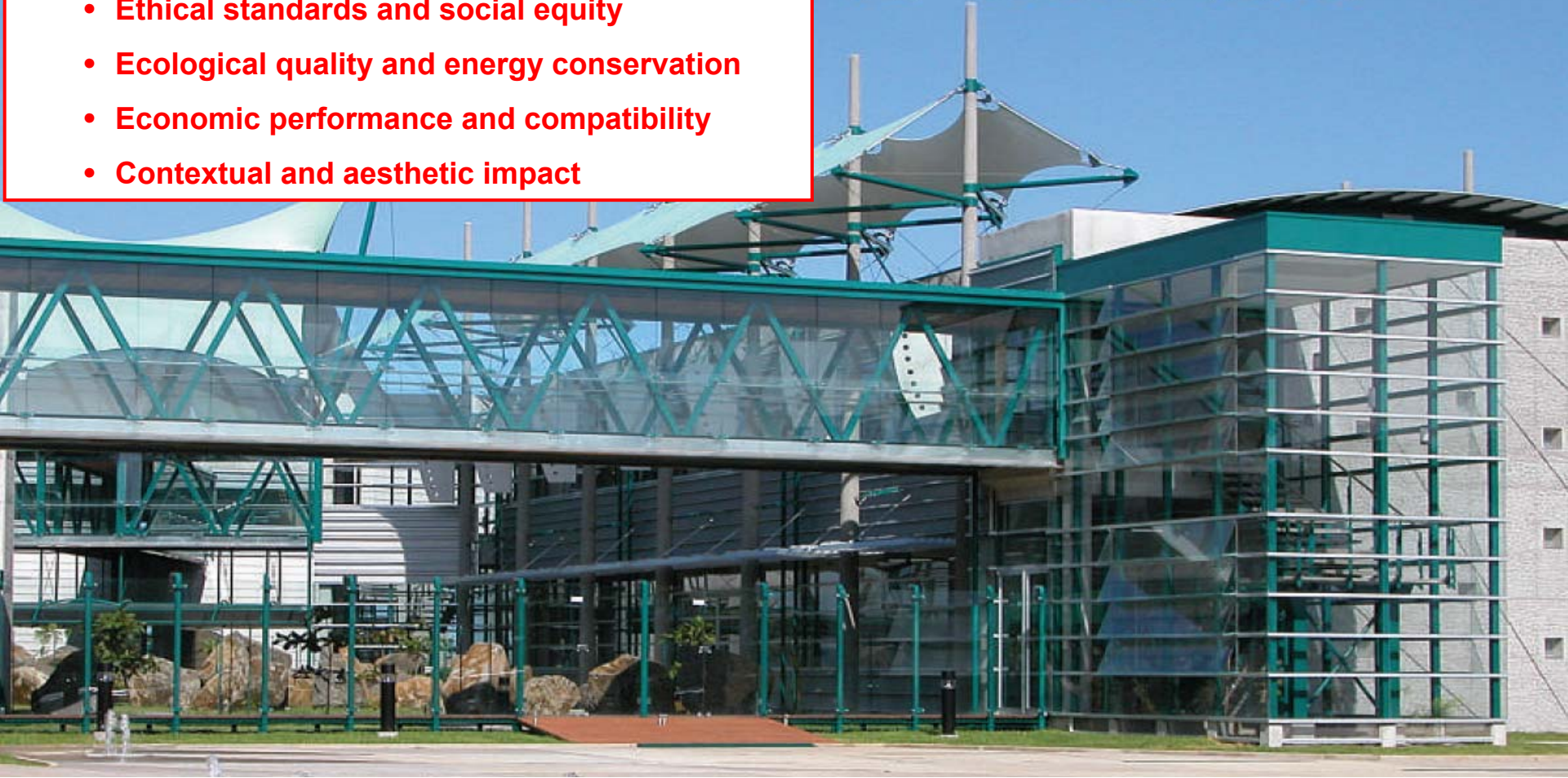
