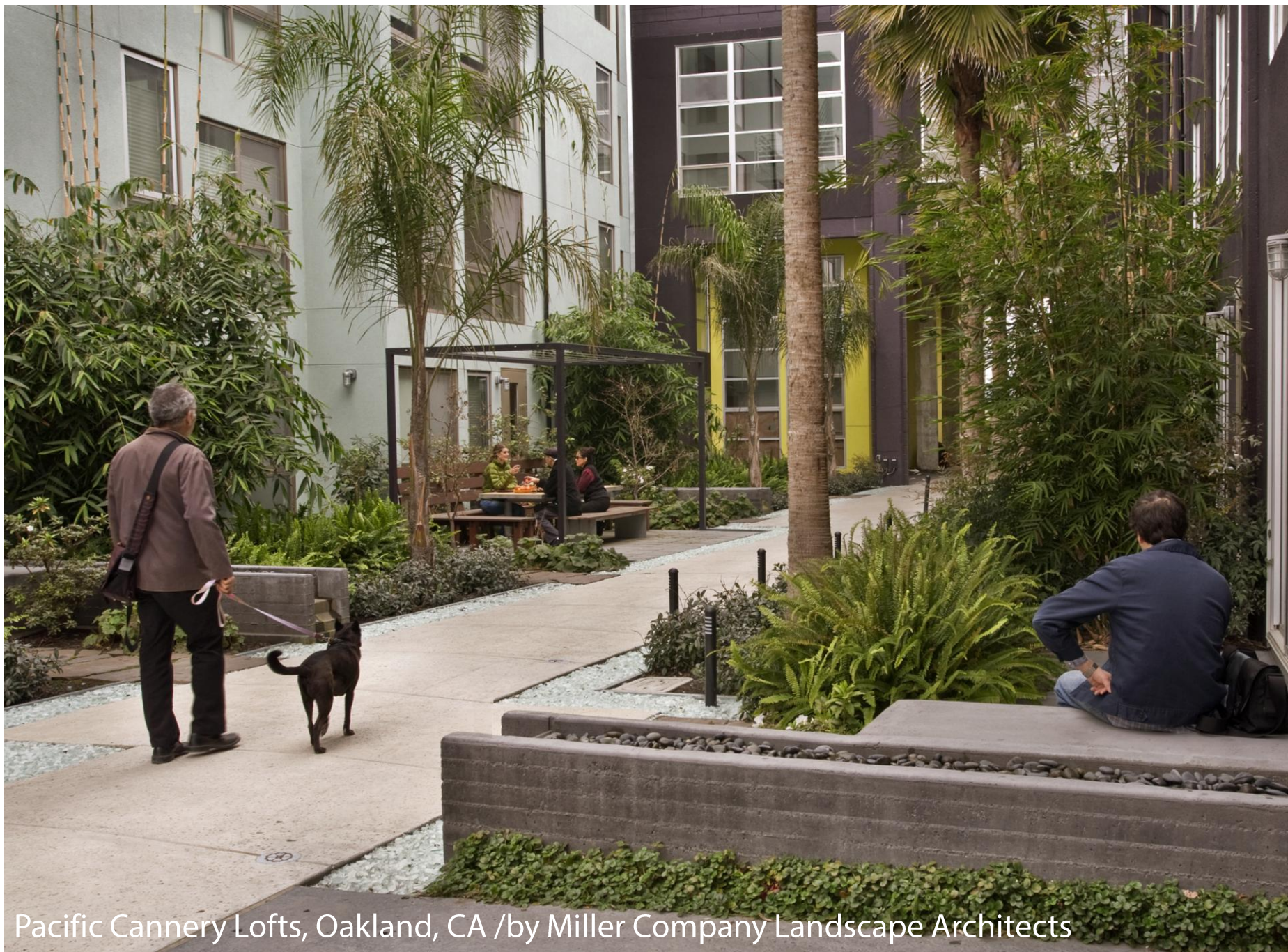

Metamorphosis of the garbage mountain of Tel Aviv and its surroundings into a park near the city

From the distance, Hiriya appears as the „mystic mountain“ in the midst of the spacious Ayalon plain. By preserving its striking silhouette from the outside, the inside becomes a landscape, an open and public mediterranean scene, in its core the fountain as the symbol for nature. In the future, the Ayalon river will meander freely, and a flat ramp will wind up to the plateau, adjusting to the existing shape. A new tree-covered terrace will support the foot of the mountain offering a wide variety of possible uses.
